## **II. New Chapters of AFST(I)**

With a view to spread the wings of AFST (I) throughout the country, we have given approval for opening four new chapters of AFST (I) at Tezpur, Raichur, Cochin & Kundli. There is increasing demand from popular institutions expressing their interest in opening chapters of AFST (I) at their places.

While we greatly appreciate the initiative of many of the chapters in conducting various activities for the benefit of their members, we reiterate our humble request that while conducting any activity (under the banner of AFST(I)) the chapters should follow guidelines and conditions provided by the Headquarters. They are reproduced here:



- The information should reach the Hq as soon as the plan of activities is finalized
- Seed money, if taken from the Hq, to be returned
- 10% of the excess of income over expenditure earned to be given to Hq
- Representation of Hq members be made compulsory in the respective committees of the conference
- Audited statement of accounts, recommendations/proceedings, utilization certificates and other documents required by the funding agencies should be sent by the chapter concerned in stipulated time with a copy to Hq, so that recommendations can be sent to the respective funding agencies and ministries.

### **III. Seminars and Lectures conducted at Headquarters**

#### **i) Seminar on Food Processing**

A one day Technical Seminar on 'Radiation Technologies for Food Processing and Agriculture and Water Resources Management' was organized by Indian Nuclear Society, Mysore branch, in association with Association of Food scientists and Technologists (India) conducted on 30th March 2013 in Rani Bahadur Auditorium, University of Mysore. This seminar was attended by 270 delegates including scientists from BARC, CSIR - CFTRI, DRDO - DFRL and students / faculty members of many science/ engineering / agriculture colleges located in and around Mysore.

Dr K. B. Sainis, Director, BMG, BARC, inaugurated the seminar and in his address he highlighted the impact of research work of BARC scientists in food and agriculture sectors at the grass root level.

Dr H V Batra, Director, DFRL, Sri V. V. Bhat, MF, AEC, Dr. Gursharan Singh, Secretary, INS, Dr. D. V. Gopinath, INS, Mysore, Dr. G. Vijayalakshmi, Sr. Scientist, CSIR - CFTRI, and Sri T. K. Bera, Project Director, BARC, Mysore, graced the occasion and spoke at length about the societal benefits derived from non-power applications of indigenous nuclear technologies.

Informative presentations were made by Dr. A. K. Sharma, BARC, on recent developments in Radiation Processing of Food and Agriculture commodities, Dr. S F D'souza, TNAU, on Radiotracers in Agriculture, Dr U Saravanakumar, BARC, on Isotope Hydrology Applications, Dr Jayathilakan, DFRL, on Ionizing Radiation for Processing of Meat and Meat Products, Dr. N. Ramamoorthy, DAE, on international cooperation for Radiation applications in Food and Agriculture and Sri S. K. Malhotra on Radiation Applications touching the lives of Common man. As a part of the seminar, an exhibition was also arranged which depicted *Radiation Technologies* developed by BARC for Food and Agriculture sectors. A panel discussion was held. A booklet comprising of full papers of the presentations was released during the seminar. Delegates expressed their happiness about joint venture of BARC, CSIR - CFTRI and DRDO - DFRL and wished for more such programmes in the future. The seminar was anchored by Sri Joseph Thomas and Vote of thanks was proposed by Dr.N.Bhaskar, Hon Secretary, AFSTI.

#### **ii) Prof JV Bhat Lecture**

AFST (I) organized Prof J V Bhat Lecture on August 2, 2013 at CFTRI Mysore. Prof. Ram Rajasekharan, Director CSIR-CFTRI, Mysore delivered the lecture on the topic '*Fatty Oil Biosynthesis in Oleaginous Yeast*'. The lecture was followed by unveiling of the IFCON 2013 Logo by Prof. Ram Rajasekharan. The excerpts of the lecture were published in the July-August 2013 issue of Indian Food Industry journal for the benefit of members.

### **IV. Purchase of a MUDA site**

We are proud to inform that AFST(I) has purchased a MUDA site with dimension 11.80 x 12.00 mtrs at a cost of Rs.39,60,000/- for the purpose of office as it was the dream of the forefathers of

AFST(I) since long. The next course of action for the incoming team would be to go in for joint venture with some developers for building a guest house/office. CEC authorized the Hon Secretary to consult a Chartered Accountant for assessing the pros-&-cons of owning the site by the association and intricacies involved therein.

## V. Publications

**Journal of Food Science & Technology:** The journal entered its 51st year of publication and in the 5th year of it is becoming online. The impact factor of the journal has reached 1.123 from .498 in the previous year. This year we have received about Rs 15, 87,032/- as royalty from M/s Springer. Efforts of the Dr N S Mahendrakar, Dr P Prabhasankar the past and present Editors-in-Chief and the Editorial Teams and M/s. Springer are commendable. The journal will be changed into a monthly periodical from the ensuing year.

**Indian Food Industry:** This journal is completing its 32nd year of Publication. The enduring efforts of Dr Umesh Hebbar, Chief Editor and his Editorial Team, in bringing the journal on time is remarkable. The name of journal has been changed as **Indian Food Industry-Mag**. The Masthead of the cover page is modified. The journal has introduced Interview Section, issues related to copyright act, E-submission of tech articles, inclusion of forthcoming events and restructured the advisory board of the journal. The structural changes of the journal are impressive.

## VI. IFCON 2013

The Central Executive Committee constituted a **Conference Activity Initiation Committee** to start the action plan of IFCON 2013. The themes proposed by the Secretary were deliberated and discussed by the CEC. The CEC unanimously decided the theme of IFCON2013 to be NSURE Healthy Foods (Nutritional Security through Sustainable Development, Research & Education for Healthy Foods). For choosing the suitable logo in line with the theme of IFCON, a contest was held. Among the logos received, suitable logo designed by the Zonal Technology Management-Business Planning & Development (ZTM-BPD) unit of CIFT, Kochi was selected as it was depicting the theme in a concise and comprehensive manner. The logo designers were duly rewarded in the inaugural function. Committees of IFCON2013 were constituted giving due representation to chapters. The final program of IFCON2013 includes a Curtain Raiser followed by inaugural function, awards conferring ceremony, technical sessions, poster sessions, panel discussion and valedictory function. For motivating the young researchers, this year we planned a Photo Caption and Essay Competition giving four thought provoking topics for students. Selected essays are included in the souvenir and best captioned photos presented on the poster boards at the venue are decided to be judged for prize.

Audited report of statement of accounts of the AFST(I) and AFST(I) Education and Publication Trust, Receipt and Payment of ICFOST-XXII for the financial year 2012-13 and Budget for 2013-14 is presented herewith for the kind perusal of the house.

### **CONTENTS OF REPORT**

Budget of Rs.49.7 lakhs towards AFST(I) and 2.0 lakhs towards AFST(I) Education and Publication Trust is estimated for the year 2013-14. The details of this planned budget can be found in the attached estimate.

Royalty of Rs. 15.87 lakhs for publishing JFST, received from Springer Ltd., and the interest on bank deposit is also raised by 2 lakhs. Major expenditures are Printing & Postage 8.00 lakhs, salary of the staff, which adds up to about Rs.12 lakhs and retirement benefits paid to Mr M S Sachidananda Rs. 5.00 lakhs. AFSTI participated in corner site e-auction made by MUDA and succeed in getting site No.916 measuring by 11.80 x 12.00+141.60 Sqm at J P Nagar, 1st Stage, D Block at a cost of Rs.39,60,000/-. AFSTI replaced the LCD digital display board in place of all manual board. Still the efforts of the team AFSTI has resulted in the generation of excess of income over expenditure of Rs.4.5 lakhs in the financial year.
