II. Membership

The present membership of AFST(I) stands at 2700 of which 1938 are life members. I am happy to inform you that 443 new members were enrolled during the year. We are making constant efforts for supplying journals to members without any interruption. Members are requested to cooperate with us by intimating about any changes in their address/designations/ mail ids etc. This will facilitate us to ensure continuous supply of journals/communications along with token number for online access of JFST.

III. Website

The Website committee is making constant efforts to make the website informative and attractive. I convey my sincere thanks to M/s. Marico for partial maintenance of website of AFST(I).

IV. *Relocation of AFST(I) Building*: We have received a letter from Administrative Officer, CSIR CFTRI for relocation of AFST(I) office from CFTRI office premises to A-Type quarters. Accordingly, the Central Executive Committee is looking for an alternative suitable place.

V. Chapters of AFST(I)

AFST has 34 chapters presently. It is observed that only few chapters out of 34 chapters are functioning actively. As such, it was felt that inactive chapters are requested to either to reactivate or else merge with the nearby chapter. During the year, Kanpur chapter which is one of the inactive chapters, expressed their interest to reactivate. In response to this, the office provided all the necessary details required by them, so that the chapter could be activated immediately. However there is no response from the chapter till the date.

VI. Guidelines and conditions for the chapters for conducting conferences at chapters

- When the chapter decides to arrange any conference/workshop under the banner of AFST(I), the information should reach the HQ as soon as the plan for activity is finalized
- Seed money, if, taken from the HQ will have to be returned
- 10% of the excess of income over expenditure earned during conference to be given to HQ
- Representation of HQ members be made compulsory in the respective committees of the conference
- Audited statement of accounts, recommendations/proceedings, utilization certificate and other
 documents required by the funding agencies should be sent by the chapter concerned in stipulated time
 with a copy to head quarter, so that recommendations can be sent to the respective funding agencies
 and ministry.
- TDS will have to be deducted from all major payments

VII. Election of Office Bearers

Mr B Vasu was nominated as the Returning Officer for the year. During the current year, the contestants were only for office of President-Designate and Vice President – Chapters. Election process was started in the month of October 2015. Calendar of events for the election are detailed below;

VIII. Annual Convention and other activities at HQ

Apart from ICFOST XXIV few more activities were organized during the year as detailed below:

World Food Day was celebrated followed by Prof J.V. Bhat Memorial Lectureon 16th October 2015 in the Assembly Hall of CSIR CFTRI, Mysore. The theme was 'Social Protection and Agriculture: Breaking the Cycle of Rural Poverty'. The program started with invocation by Ms Susmita Burman, a PhD Student of CFTRI. Mr S G Walde, Hon. Secretary, AFST(I) welcomed the dignitaries and participants. Mr Walde spoke briefly about the origin of 'World Food Day' celebrations. Dr B B Borse made introduction of the dignitaries. The program was anchored by Dr Kalpana Platel, Principal Scientist, CSIR CFTRI. Prof. Ram Rajasekharan, Director, CSIR- CFTRI was the Chief Guest who enlightened the participants with his remark on New Complete Foods for poor farmers which was a mesmerizing and thrilling experience for the audience. Dr. M.M. Krishna, Past President & Director, US Soybean Export Council welcomed the gathering, briefed the significance of World Food Day. Shri A. Satyanarayana, President, AFST(I), Hyderabad Chapter explained the activities of AFST (I), Hyderabad Chapter. Dr.K.V.S.A. Rao, President, OTAI (SZ) briefed the gathering about the activities of OTAI and Dr.P. Uday Kumar, HOD & Senior Deputy Director (Extension & Training), NIN, Hyderabad briefed about the activities of NIN, Hyderabad. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. D. N. Kulkarni, President, Agri-Food Division, Jain Irrigation Systems Limited, Jalgaon, Maharashtra. Both the dignitaries cherished their memories pertaining to their career and expressed

The chief guest and the other dignitaries were presented with a fruit basket, memento engraved with world food day theme 2015. All the sponsors were presented a memento encrypted with the World Food Day Theme, 2015. Dr. (Mrs.) T. Jyothirmayi, Hon. Secretary proposed vote of thanks.

Two lectures were organized during technical session. Dr. B. Madhusudan, Professor of Biochemistry and Food Technology, Davanagere University, Davanagere, spoke on "Revolutionizing Nano Technology: Promise to break the cycle of rural poverty and hunger" and Dr. M.V.R. Prasad, Former Director, DOR, Hyderabad, Director and Chief Scientific Officer, Vayugrid, Hyderabad spoke on "Some thoughts towards remedying the sinking economy of the small farmers in India. The chairman for this session was Dr. R.B.N. Prasad, Platinum Jubilee Mentor and former Chief Scientist & Head, Centre for Lipid Research, IICT, Hyderabad. The speakers and the chairman of the technical session were honoured.

The **Students' session** was chaired by Dr. G. Venkateswaran, Chief Scientist & Head, CSIR CFTRI Resource Centre, Hyderabad. Essay writing competition was conducted where 45 essays were received from different Universities. Among them, four best essays were selected and students were given a chance to present on the World food day related theme "Social Security and Agriculture -Breaking the Cycle of Rural Poverty". They were given an opportunity to speak on the topic with Power Point presentations and were judged for First, Second, Third prizes and a consolation prize based on their hand written essays as well as their PP presentations. All the participants of Essay writing competition were given Participation certificates. The winners are Ms. Feroza Begum, (M.Sc. (Food Technology), Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupathi (IV Prize) and were awarded with cash prizes along with a memento engraved with World Food Day Theme. Three out station student winners were provided with travel allowance.

The main attraction of the Seminar was **Quiz programme** which was conducted by Mr. Kodanda Rami Reddy, Associate Professor, OUCT, Hyderabad. Nine teams (18 participants) of students pursuing Food Science and Technology from various colleges and universities participated in this programme. Winners were given Cash prizes, winning certificates, participation certificates and mementoes made with world food day theme and other participants were given only participation certificates. The First Prize went to Ms. Rahila Rawoof and Ameena Muneer (OU College for Women), Kothi, Hyderabad, Second Prize to Mr N. Surender Reddy and Ms. S. Priyanka (M. Tech. Food Technology), Osmania University, College of Technology, Hyderabad; Third Prize to Ms. A. Kiranmayi and Ms. Sana Bushra, M.Sc. (Applied Nutrition), NIN, Hyderabad. The audience who answered questions were also presented with pens. The winners were awarded winning certificate, cash prizes.

The participants were comprised of members of AFST (I), NIN staff, OTAI (SZ), faculty from different universities, industry professionals and a large number of students. All the participants were provided with a Folder, a Memo pad printed with World Food Day 2015 theme and a Pen sponsored by M/s Enerzi Microwave Systems, Dharwad. Wafer biscuits provided by Shri K. Abraham, WAFCO Food Technologies, Hyderabad were distributed to the delegates. High Tea and Lunch and Tea were arranged for all the participants, who attended the programme. The Program was well appreciated by all the participants. Efforts were made to enroll new members as well as to get the memberships renewed from time to time. IMPHAL CHAPTER: Imphal Chapter organized two days' National Conference on "Prospects and challenges in Indigenous Foods and Drinks Sector" during 11 - 12 April 2015 at Central Agricultural University, Iroisemba, Imphal. The event was sponsored by the Department of Commerce and Industries, Government of Manipur.

MUMBAI CHAPTER: AFST – Mumbai team comprising Dr. K. D. Yadav, Dr. Uday Annapure, Dr. Nilesh Amritkar, Mr. M. M. Chitale, Mr. Nilesh Lele and Advocate Srikant Ingle headed by President Mr. Prabodh Halde met with His Excellency Shri. Vidyasagar Rao, Governor of Maharashtra on July 18th 2015. Mr. Halde presented a White Paper on "Food Processing Status and Way Forward in State of Maharashtra" and highlighted that Maharashtra's contribution to the Indian Food Processing industry is 13%, but it can increase to 25% with focused approach. Agriculture and Food Processing contributes 17.2% to total GDP of India, however it supports a whopping 60% population. For a complete copy of the White Paper, please visit our website at http://afstimumbai.org/. His Excellency advised that India has land, labor but what is lacking is coordination. He has special interest in uplifting the tribal farmer. Dr. Annapure suggested honey, gum and other products that are available in forests but not commercialized as yet. His Excellency suggested to present proposals to support tribal, marginal and poor farmers and he will issue notifications to support such projects. Key takeaway was that Governor's office will identify areas that can be adopted by AFST – Mumbai and help implement measures to uplift the farmers. The session concluded with presenting a basket of Kokan based products of Exelon Basket, company founded by our Secretary Mr. Nilesh Lele.

FSSAI recently released Draft Regulations for Nutraceuticals and Additives. AFST-Mumbai conducted a workshop on "Nutra and Additives Draft Regulations" on 21st August 2015 where 120+ industry participants attended the Workshop. Mr. Prabodh Halde, President, Mumbai chapter welcomed all the guests and briefed about purpose of the program. Dr H. Kamble FDA Commissioner opened the workshop and also inaugurated the website of AFST – Mumbai (http://www.afstimumbai.org/). Mr. Ajay Yadav is designer of the website. Special Guests at the workshop were Dr. Vilas Shirhatti, Mr. Suresh Dongare, Ex-Director FSSAI & Mr. Suresh Annapure, Joint commissioner FDA Mumbai. Lead presentations on Nutra and Additives were delivered by Ms. Tirtha Gala, Ms. Chetana Bhandari and Ms. Subha Nishtala. This session was chaired by Mr. Raghu Guda and Co-chaired by DrUday Annapure, ICT Mumbai. Post lunch the attendees were divided in various groups per their individual choices and they worked on comments to be submitted to FSSAI, this session was coordinated by Mr. M.M.Chitale and Dr.Nilesh Amritkar. The collation of the data is being done and will be circulated to all attendees, FDA Maharashtra, FSSAI and all the stakeholders prior to the November deadline as announced by FSSAI. Vote of thanks was given by Mr. Nilesh Lele, Hon secretary of Mumbai chapter.

On August 26th "Nutrition Week" was organized at Dr. BMN College of Home Science, Matunga. Dr Rashmi Kolhe, Treasurer Mumbai chapter was one of the coordinators. Mr. Harpal Singh was the chief guest o the event who guided the students in choosing their careers. TREASURER'S REPORT

Dear Members,

Audited report of statement of accounts of the AFST(I) and AFST(I) Education and Publication Trust Receipt and Payment of ICFoST XXVVV for the financial year 2014-15 and Budget for 2015-16 is presented herewith for the kind perusal of the house.

CONTENTS OF AUDITORS REPORT

The report contains:

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

All the expenditures incurred during the financial year 2014-15 are within the corresponding budget estimate. With regard to income, compared to last year, the income Membership fee is decreased by Rs. 1,95,145/-. This was due to increased memberships prior to IFCON resulting in receipt of more fee amount. The advertisement in IFI Mag increased by Rs 3, 27, 765/-which includes of previous year dues received in this financial year. Miscellaneous income increased by 1, 04,599/-which comprises Rs.39,500/- from rent of display board and Rs.70,000/- transferred from surplus receipt of coffee vending machine. The royalty received from M/s. Springer was Rs.1,08,50,950/- this includes Rs.26,19,987 pertaining to 2013 and Rs.82,30,963 for the year 2014. Interest on FD decreased by Rs.3,02,619/- due to withdrawal of some FDs for payment towards AFSTI site and some other FDs converted to re-investment Deposit scheme. The interest will be taken into account on maturity.

In the expenditure side, IFI printing increased by 1,90,869/- this inclusive of 6 issue of 2014 and 1 issue of 2015 in total 7 issue; Annual increase of staff salary by Rs.1,70,160; Postage by 28,335; Travelling expenses by 11,519. In this year AFST(I) Organised Dr H A B Parpia and Mr G C P Rangarao memorial lecture at Kollam wherein the expenditure incurred was Rs.27, 220/-

It was observed that, in spite of reminders from HQ the audited statements of some of the chapters could not be received till date. I request to the chapters once again to submit their audited account before June 30 of every year. It is very essential to finalise the AFST(I) account well in time and also avoid future income tax objection.

In the Education and Publication Trust Auditor advised to show some transaction apart from the Scholarship in the trust to avoid query from Income Tax department hence Rs.1,00,000/- transferred to AFST(I) and utilised towards printing of IFImag.

BUDGET:

Budget of Rs.1,08,82,000/- towards AFST(I) and Rs.2,00,000.00 towards AFST(I) Education and Publication Trust is estimated for the year 2015-16. The details of this planned budget can be found in the attached estimate.
