The website committee met several times and discussed about the aesthetic improvement of the site and the website was re-designed. The committee also discussed about the charges fixed by AFST(I) to other organizations for sending emails related to job opportunities and it was decided to charge Rs.10,000/- for MNCs and Rs.5,000/- for Indian Companies. Since the present web space in server (300 MB) was insufficient, it was enhanced to 1GB. Efforts are being made to provide online registration link in the newly designed website on trial basis. We thank M/s. Marico for renewing the sponsorship of AFST(I) website for the current year.

II. New Chapters of AFST(I)

The CEC in its first meeting, accorded permission to start a new Chapter of AFST(I) at Kollam considering their overwhelming response in membership drive. Similarly, on request of IICPT, Thanjavur, it was approved to start a chapter there. The newly approved Thanjavur chapter is to be inaugurated on 4th of January 2013 by Hon'ble Union Minister for Agriculture Shri Sharad Pawar during the International Conference of IICPT, Thanjavur. We have also made efforts to revive Trivandrum chapter. A request has come from Cochin also for opening a chapter there. We are glad that various institutions are expressing their interest in opening chapters of AFST(I) and enrolling members.

It is also gratifying to note that many of the chapters are conducting various activities for the benefit of the members. It is our humble request to all the chapters that while conducting any activity under the banner of AFST(I) to keep in mind the following guidelines and conditions.

- The information should reach the HQ as soon as the plan for activity is finalized
- Seed money, if, taken from the HQ to be returned
- 10% of the excess of income over expenditure earned to be given to HQ
- Representation of HQ members be made compulsory in the respective committees of the conference
- Audited statement of accounts, recommendations/proceedings, utilization certificate and other documents required by the funding agencies should be sent by the chapter concerned in stipulated time with a copy to head quarter, so that recommendations can be sent to the respective funding agencies and ministry.

III. Scientific workshop on Nutrition and Food Safety

AFST(I) in association with Nestle Nutrition Institute (NNI) organized a Workshop on "Recent trends in Nutrition & Food Safety" on 02-08-2012 at CSIR-CFTRI, Mysore. The NNI is a not a profit organization based in Switzerland with an objective of sharing science based information and education. The Institute fosters "Science for Better Nutrition" to contribute to the enhancement of the quality of life all over the world.

Dr G Vijayalakshmi, President, AFST(I) welcomed the dignitaries and introduced them along with the invited speakers. The workshop was inaugurated with the lighting of lamp by all the dignitaries. Mr N Krishnakumar, Regional Scientific Affairs Manager, NNI, briefed about the theme of the workshop.

Dr H V Batra, Director, DFRL, in his presidential remarks, pointed out the importance of food safety in day-to-day life and also stressed its impact on the society in general. Dr Jeyarani T, Hon. Secretary, AFST(I), gave vote of thanks and wrapped up the inaugural function.

Eminent scientists from National Institute of Nutrition, Hyderabad were the speakers for the workshop. Dr A Laxmaiah, Scientist, NIN, Hyderabad spoke on the Diet related to non communicable chronic diseases with special focus on Obesity and Diabetics. Dr G N V Brahmam, talked on the Micronutrient deficiencies and their Management Strategies. Topic of Risk Assessment of Chemical Contaminants was presented by Dr V Sudershan Rao, whereas Current Scenario of Food Labelling in India was delivered by Dr G M Subba Rao.

About 190 registered delegates including 52 students attended for the workshop.

IV. Publications

Journal of Food Science & Technology: The journal entered its 50th year of publication in the 4th year of it's becoming online. The impact factor of the journal has reached 0.498 in 2011 as against its previous impact factor of 0.477 in 2010. This year we have received about Rs 11.4 lakhs as royalty from M/s Springer. Efforts of the Editor-in-Chief and his Editorial Team & M/s. Springer are really praiseworthy. AFST(I) is planning to celebrate Golden Jubilee of JFST journal in the year 2013. The following topics have been selected for the Golden Jubilee issue of JFST i.e. Vol. 50, 2013:

1. Designer foods
2. Solar energy in food processing
3. Nutrigenomics
4. Biosensors in food processing
5. Nano technology in food processing
6. Genetically modified foods

The articles from experts in the respective fields on the above topics will be published in 6 issues of JFST during the Golden Jubilee year 2013.

Indian Food Industry: This journal has entered its 32nd year of Publication. Dr P Prabhasankar, Chief Editor and his Editorial Team, has brought out the journal with their unwearied efforts which is really noteworthy. The journal with its reinforced look is attracting more and more number of industries for projecting their company and its products in New Product Showcase and also as Company Write ups.

V. ICFoST XXII

In its first meeting CEC decided to organize current year's Annual Convention for two days at Mysore. In the subsequent meeting, considering the relevance to the present day requirements, where food security and safety are burning issues, the theme was selected as "SAFEST (Safety Assurance of Foods through Emerging Science & Technology) Innovations". EFFORTS FOR FUND GENERATION
