## ABOUT THE SEMINAR

India's food production has been consistent and encouraging, especially after the green revolution in early 1970s. In spite of continued productivity constraints in case of many crops, India's food production was significant and consistent. This increasing trend in production and productivity was, however, not realized adequately in case of pulses and oilseeds resulting in continued dependence on import for these commodities. Alongside the rising trends in food production, rapid developments in the area of food processing contributed significantly to the cause of overall food security and food safety in the country. Food processing gave a big impetus to enlarging the gross food availability by significantly reducing the post-harvest losses. Setting up a separate Ministry for Food Processing Industries in mid 1980s by the Govt of India has greatly helped in rapid development of the sector. In spite of the significant accomplishments in areas of agricultural production and food processing, our food security situation is still not very comfortable.

To address and deliberate on the emerging issues of high national relevance, the Association of Food Scientists and Technologists (India), Hyderabad Chapter in association with AFST (I) Mysuru is organising a one-day National Seminar on "Emerging Trends in Food Processing Technologies for Food Security and Safety" as a part of its Golden Jubilee Celebrations at CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Technology, Hyderabad on July 20, 2024. CSIR - Central Food Technological Research Institute, Resource Centre, Hyderabad and Oil Technologists' Association of India (Southern Zone), Hyderabad are the knowledge partners for this event. The inaugural session of the Seminar will include Late Sri P V Suryaprakasa Rao Memorial Lecture which will be delivered by an eminent food scientist on the theme of the seminar. Lectures on sustainable technologies in the processing of food products, in addition to food safety and regulatory issues will be deliberated by eminent speakers.

This event is an ideal platform for the deliberations, networking and exchange of knowledge among researchers, students and industry personnel. Oral and Poster presentation opportunities will be provided to research scholars and post graduate students, who are pursuing their studies in the area of food science and technology

Poster abstract should be submitted to the organising Secretary by e-mail (afstihydchap@gmail.com) on or before **June 25, 2024** on any field of food science/technology and allied areas with special emphasis on the theme of the conference. Presenting authors must register for the conference as a delegate. Poster abstracts should be limited to maximum 150 words. The posters should be prepared with dimensions of 3 x 3 ft and the font should be bold and visible from a distance of 3 meters. For submission of posters, kindly refer the guidelines/format attached to this brochure.
